

## Information for Taza PartyNights

### Booking info:

To book a Taza PartyNight we will need you to provide us with some details so that we can make a provisional booking. To confirm the booking you must then provide us with a £10/person deposit which can be paid in person or over the phone using a credit/debit card, this should be received by us by close of business on the Sunday before your booking night.

Below, you will find a list of our terms and conditions, please read them as they are very relevant to your night and we certainly don't view them as small print.

1. If your booking is made up of more than 10 people then we cannot guarantee that the whole party can sit at one table. If tables are split then we will never sit other people in between your tables.
2. Drinks must be ordered and paid for at your table.
3. We are very strict with our proof of age policy for alcohol. If any of your group members are between 18 and 24 we strongly advise them to bring ID on the night, we will always refuse alcohol to anybody we suspect might be under 18.
4. At Taza we maintain a sensible drinking policy and we reserve the right to stop serving alcohol to anybody to whom **we** decide has had enough. We can at anytime demand that any individual leave our premises.
5. It is not permissible at any time to stand on seating or tables anybody doing so will be required to leave.
6. The fine for bringing any drinks into Taza is £150, these terms form part of a legally binding contract.
7. We will only refund deposits if we are notified of changes to your booking by close of business on the Thursday night before your booking.
8. Any of your guests arriving after food service will not be served food, but the price for the night remains the same
9. We do not allow people to enter the restaurant who have not paid the full amount for the night, this includes well wishers and people just saying hello.
10. Please inform us, at the latest, 3 days before your booking if anybody requires a European meals or a European Vegetarian meal. The options for European meals are: [Chicken Maryland, Omelettes, Breaded Haddock, Breaded Scampi, Chicken Nuggets or Fish Fingers \(all items served with chips and salad\)](#). Please try to keep these to a minimum as it slows down food service considerably.
11. It is your responsibility to ensure all party attendees agree to our Terms and conditions.
12. We Take photographs on the night which we put on our website for you to view any time; we may use these for promotional material.
13. We do not honour all Karaoke song requests.

### What happens on the night.

On a Taza PartyNight we reserve the right to choose one of two ways in which to serve the food.

It may be the case that the buffet is open for you to help yourself and if a European meal has been pre-ordered then you should notify a member of staff who organise this for you. At the end of your meal you will be presented with a bill for the partynight charge taking in to account any deposits which apply (see above terms).

Alternatively you will find poppadoms and chutneys on the table so you can have a nibble with your drink while the rest of your group assembles. We will commence your meal when all of your party has arrived. If anybody has pre-ordered a European meal then they should notify the waiter/waitress who confirms the meals at the table.

Starters will then be served on a mixed platter, meat on one side and vegetarian on the other. If at any time you run out of starters you can ask a member of staff for a top up free of charge.

Once your starter plates have been cleared, your table will automatically be served main course at the next available opportunity. Main course dishes are brought to the table, six in total, along with rice and Naan bread; again, if you run out of a particular dish, just ask a member of staff for a top up, you will not be charged for food top ups.

When your main course plates have been cleared, a member of the waiting staff will ask how many people will be having dessert. The reason we ask, and do not just bring everybody a dessert, is that many people decline because they've had a substantial meal. We offer just one dessert item which is generally a slice of gateau with cream.

After this time we clear the tables and issue bills for the remaining payment less your deposit for each person who attended.

The Party now begins with great music and Karaoke books are handed out for you to choose songs to sing if you wish. We do not play all requests.

All drink orders must be given to waiting staff who will serve you your drinks and take your payment at the table after each order and return with your change. If you would like a kitty jar then please ask.

Last orders for drinks is usually at 12:30am, this can be sooner on some occasions but you will always be notified 10 minutes before hand so you can get your orders in on time.

If you need a taxi home then we suggest you pre-order it for 12:45am. Please do not ask staff to call taxis as waiting time before somebody even picks the phone up at the taxi company can be 10 minutes if they pick up at all; always pre-arrange your transport. In all circumstances we can not allow you to stay on the premises after 1:00am and any drinks still on the table at this time will be taken away.
